Expenses in 2009:

- Total for 19 people: \$22,874.36 (\$1,203.91 per person).
- Major expenditures:
- \$3,352.16 donations (\$860 in 2007)
- \$15,181.00 airfare (\$7,599.95 in 2007)
- \$1854.84 food (\$938 in 2007)
- \$930 transportation within Dominica
- \$926.68 lodging (\$1340 in 2007)
- \$474 exit tax (\$220 in 2007)

Funds raised in 2007: \$9,631.35

Deficit: \$(1,680.29)

Funds raised in 2008: \$2000

2009 projected airfare: \$800 per person
